Base jumping entails a jumper to leap of chosen spots in accordance to its acronym of B – Building, A- Antenna, S- Span and E- Earth and standing tall at 122 meters high, Menara Tun Mustapa is a perfect launching pad for these dare devils.

Besides waiting for their heroes at ground level, base jumping aficionados can also get closer to their heroes in action just by lounging around in the famous revolving restaurant, Atmosphere, on the 18th floor of the tower.

But, not to be forgotten, after your meal, visit the ground events especially catered to your interests and needs.

The KL Tower International Jump 2008, is indeed a full fledged festival, right from the bottom, at the ground level, up to the top of the Menara Tun Mustapa.

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
